NAPA COUNTY LAW LIBRARY RELOCATES BACK TO THE HISTORIC COURTHOUSE

NAPA, CA—The Superior Court of Napa County is pleased to announce that the Napa County Law Library reopened its doors to the bench, bar, and people of Napa County on Wednesday, February 13, 2019.

The Law Library returned home to the Napa County Historic Courthouse from its temporary location in the Napa County Public Library, where it has operated for the last several years. In August of 2014, law library services, along with court operations, were displaced from the historic courthouse because of damages from the South Napa Earthquake.

The Napa County Law Library is a practice library, focusing on practical materials for attorneys and lay persons. Use of the library's collection is free to all who enter the library. There are also public access terminals available within the library with access to law related resources, and a Law Librarian that is available to provide appropriate resources to meet the legal research and information needs of library patrons.

Law library hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. from Monday through Friday. The Law Librarian provides onsite services from 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. each weekday.

To access the Napa County Law Library, patrons should enter through the main doors of the historic courthouse located at 825 Brown Street, between Second and Third Streets. The law library is on the 1st floor near the grand staircase.
